- Recognized by UCLA, UNOS and the American Liver Foundation.
- We continued to provide hundreds of hours of online support groups, free one-on-one counseling sessions.
- Received referrals from across the US- from families, physicians, hospitals and the ALF.
- A major development: We now have advocated directly and successfully for AUD patients in dire need of transfers to transplant centers for emergency evaluation; opinions terminal in outlook became portals to life.
- As we grew, we filled another need- to offer our support and care during times of grief, solitude and regrowth for the families of loved ones who were unfortunate to not reach their hoped for outcome.

We were honored to host our 2nd Annual Transplant Family Picnic in October, where over 90 members of our community attended- including more than 30 liver transplant recipients!

### Online Support Groups

-Liver Transplant biweekly: 3+ hrs due to demand!  
-Transplant AUD/SUD Hybrid weekly: 1 hr- only such independent US group.  
-Caregiver biweekly: Coming in 2025.

- Average 20+ attendees per meeting.
- 85% return rate.
- 90+% believe in its benefits as essential.

### One-on-One Counseling Sessions

-Free 1 hr bookable slots: One off, occasional, or weekly (ongoing).  
-Sobriety coaching and general mental & spiritual health.  
-Patient advocacy at all stages.

- 97% sobriety beyond 2 years with regular attendance, ongoing sessions.
- 90%+ believe it is vital to their recovery from transplant, mental & overall health.

### Dedicated Helpline, Website & Patient Advocacy

-Calls answered 24/7/365.  
-Address liver failure due to AUD and SUD directly.  
-Advocate for AUD patients in need of emergency transplant evaluation.

- 100% calls & emails answered within 8 hrs, 82% answered immediately.
- Hundreds of site visitors from all over the world each month.
